

## Public Safety/ Judiciary – SF 802

Summary: The target is \$123.6 M in FY 20/21 and \$151.4 M in FY 22/23.

### Compromise:

Take Senate May 20, 4:33pm offer with below modifications:

- Add \$2M in FY 20/21 ongoing to the staffing request of the Public Defense Board
- Add \$1.309 M in FY 20/21 ongoing for DOC Office of Ombudsman with policy included (HF1399)
- Add \$291,000 in FY 20/21 ongoing for a civic engagement FTE at Department of Human Rights
- Eliminate Senate position on DOC technology to fund the above items

### Policy:

- All additional, previously agreed-to policy included in attachments labeled PS 1 and PS 2
  - Except HF 1236: the regulation of drones/UAV – must come out
  - Including Murdered and Missing Indigenous Women Task Force included in both Senate and House offers
- 2 non-controversial DPS policy/technical bills:
  1. Micro distillery clean-up language
  2. Cigarette propensity account clarification
- Include language of SF 111: Reform to predatory offender clarification
- Include language of HF 418: Working group on criminal sexual statutory reform, *as amended.*
- Include language of agreed to language on DWI ignition interlock forfeiture reform (Senate position)
