

Laws Authored by Women Legislators in 1923

Please note this list is likely to be incomplete. It will not include any laws which were passed as Senate Files where the companion bill may have been authored by a woman House member. I do not see a companion index to easily find companion bill numbers. It also does not include omnibus-type laws which would have included language from bills authored by women legislators, but passed as a part of another bill.

Also note that these laws are for the year 1923 only.
